Annual tuition ranges from 2,900 Euros (fields in the humanities) 8,800 Euros (medical programs). Tuition fees depend on the field of study.

Application requirements:

- An online application, which requires a fee of around 200 Euros.
- IELTS for students from non-English speaking high schools. A minimum score of 6.5 is required. Please note the IELTS score is valid for two years from the time of exam.
- Medical programs require a written exam and an oral interview. No specific courses are required, however, for students to be able to pass the entrance exams, they must have a background in Biology and Chemistry. The fee for the entrance exams is currently 250 Euros.
- For some other fields, an interview is required.
- Students following a school grading system out of 20, students should have at least a 17 average. A higher score is preferable for medical programs.
- Students following a school grading system out of 10, students should have at least a 7. A higher score is preferable for medical programs.
- Students following the UK iGCSE and A level educational system should have at least 6 iGCSE's grade C (4 out of 9) in all subjects, at least grade C in AS levels, and good predications for A levels. Higher scores are preferable for medical programs.
- School transcripts for the last three years are required and officially translated into English.
- Valid passport
